



Additional Information

This form must be received by June 28, 2016 and must include a \$10.00 non-refundable deposit per shooter. Deposit will be applied to entry fees. Partial or full squads should be mailed in the same envelope. If you mail pre-squad forms together and do not want to squad together, please say so. This will be the only method for pre-squadding. Squadding based on the rules in ATA Section IV, G, 2.

PRE-SQUADDING ENDS June 28

After Pre-Squadding ends, you must have a PAID UP, FILLED-OUT Entry form for anyone you wish to squad. We intend to keep short squads to a minimum. Mail this form with deposit to: (Make checks payable to: HTC, c/o Rick Dorr, DND Cashering, 2616 Central Ave, Great Falls, MT 59401.) AIM Team Captains send team's MSTA, ATA information to Rick Dorr by June 28, 2016.

*** If you pre-squaded and had a ydg change or can not attend please notify Rick by mail or email ric3677@bresnan.net. Shooters pre-squadding for Saturday and/or Sunday only are not assured a spot on early squads.

Added Money

A total of \$13,600.00 of added money is open to all shooters. This is divided among several events as listed in the program. No special entry fee is required to participate. This money is provided by: MSTA \$4,308.00; ATA \$4,692.00; Jim Jones \$2,000 Butte medal, Budweiser \$1,000, NorthWestern Energy \$500 and the Helena Trap Club \$1,000.

The MSTA will add \$1,000, open to Montana residents only, awarded to class winners in the HOA (Events 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14). Participation requires no special entry fee and classification will be based on shooter's class in Event 8. The five classes will each be divided \$100.00 - \$60.00 - \$40.00, high-gun.

Squadding

Contestants are requested to make entry for the entire program. Money will be refunded on any uncontested event provided you notify the cashier of your intention to withdraw before the event starts. We hope to hold the number of short squads to a minimum. Turn in all your entries at the same time as soon as you enter if you want to hold your spot in a squad. If you miss your squad, a \$10.00 charge will be made to re-enter. If the weather is bad and you miss your squad, you will not be allowed to reenter if the weather improves.

Pre-registration

An advanced squadding form is contained in this program. This form must be received by June 28, 2016 to be considered, and must include a \$10.00 non-refundable deposit. Please make checks payable to the Helena Trap Club. (Deposit will be applied to the entry fees.) Management is not responsible for late entries. This is the only method used for pre-squadding. No phone calls will be accepted. Partial or full squads will be accepted but they should all be submitted in the same envelope. Upon arriving at the shoot: 1) Go to the Handicap table, pick up entry form, be classified (have your averages current). 2) Go directly to the cashier to pay entry. Squad and post will already be marked on your entry form.

High Gun Payoffs

The number of pays in a High Gun Payoff is determined by how many shooters enter the event. In the Montana State Shoot, one place will be paid for each quantity filled and a place for any fraction thereof. In a 1-in-7 event, one place is paid for each seven entries and one more place is paid if there are any remaining entries. For example: 21 entries pay three places, 22 entries pay four places. Four places are paid until there are 29 entries.

Parking

In order to facilitate orderly movement throughout the camper area, we request people with campers to check with the attendant who will assign spaces for campers and towing vehicles. MSTA Standard Procedures

Penalty Yardage and Classification

The handicap committee must assign a minimum of 24 yards and class A singles and class A doubles to any shooter that does not have 500 singles, 500 handicap and 500 doubles in the current and previous year combined.

Class Winners

The winner of any Class Event advances to the next highest class for the remain-der of the shoot. The shooter must advise the cashier of such changes for options and purse calculations. The High-in-State and High-Out-of-State shooter and all ties, by Class, in Friday's Class Singles and Thursday's Class Doubles events advance.

All-State Team

Shooters must have at least 1500 Singles, 1500 Handicap, and 1000 Doubles to qualify. The same applies to all special catagories that make the All-State Team, they must vacate the special category award allowing the next high shooter in the special category to move up. To qualify for the All-State Team a person must shoot the championship events at the State Shoot.

MSTA Champion of Champions Event

This event will be shot on the first half of the State Singles Championship. It is open only to Montana shooters who are members of paid-up MSTA member clubs. Each club champion must pay a \$1.00 entry fee and place his name on the list provided. There will be a trophy and \$50.00 to the winner. Ties shoot-off for both trophy and money. Shoot-offs: If a tie exists, reverse score on 25's will be used. If still undecided, there will be a head-to-head shoot-off.

Trophies and Special Trophies

All shooters eligible to shoot for Special Trophies must advise the cashier to place their names on the lists provided on the bulletin board. Trophies will be on display in the trophy case in the clubhouse. A list of each day's winners will be posted there also. Please pick up trophies from Trophy Committe daily.

Runner Up Shoot off Rules

IThere will be no shoot offs for category R/U trophies. For these awards the following will be used to resolve ties. All ties in the singles and doubles will carry over to the next like event by sub event. If there are still ties at the end of the shoot they will be broken by long run from the back. If still tied, the winner will be declared by lot. Ties in handicap will be resolved in the following manner. Score shot by trap from trap #1, trap #2, trap #3, and then trap #4 on the event the tie occurred. If still tied, long run from the front, then long run from back. If still tied, the winner will be declared by lot. HOA ties will be resolved by Handicap scored starting with the championship handicap total score then preliminary handicap total score. If still tied, long run from back on championship then long run from back on preliminary.

High Average Awards

To qualify for a Montana State High Average Award, a shooter must have either 1500 Singles or 1500 Handicap or 1000 Doubles.

State Singles Championship

State Singles Championship will be decided on 200 targets, Events 10 & 13. The MSTA will provide funds to the State Champion or Runner-Up, provided he or she agrees to enter the Champion of Champions race at the Grand American Handicap if eligible. ATA RULES allow only the State Champion or Runner-Up to enter the Champion of Champions event. In All Cases the recipient of these monies must enter the Champion of Champions event at the Grand to receive this expense money from the MSTA. The winner is to notify the MSTA secretary as soon as possible whether they will or will not be able to attend the Grand. If the Champion or Runner-Up does not attend the Grand, the Day fees are retained in the MSTA treasury and awarded at the following year's state shoot in the following manner. The money is to be rounded down to the nearest \$500.00 and awarded as Added Money to the High All Around winners by class (AA, A, B, C, D) High Gun 50-30-20 closed to out of state shooters.

Declare Special Categories

All special catagory shooters must declare their special category at the time of their entry in any registered event. Without such a declaration at the time of entry, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. No exceptions to this rule are to be allowed. See ATA section IV, J, section X, 3,4,5.

Trap and Field

The MSTA will give Champion and Runner-Up of the four ATA Championship Events a one year subscription to Trap and Field magazine. The winners must contact the MSTA secretary.

Resident

He or she must have met the legal and Amateur Trapshooting Association requirements for citizenship in the State of Montana. He may not have participated in the state shoot for any other state, representing himself as a resident of that state and eligible for state shooting titles of that state, within the calendar year last preceding the Montana State Trapshooting Association's last state trapshoot. If he is desirous of transferring his membership from any other state to Montana and becoming a member of this Association, he shall inform the MSTA of his intentions at least six months prior to any Montana State shoot to be eligible to participate in same. A shooter without a permanent Amateur Trapshooting Association card shall be required to qualify his residency with the Montana State Trapshooting Association delegate or the handicap committee.

General Information

- All targets will be registered with the ATA except the Butte medal, and shooters must be ATA members.
- ATA and MSTA fees apply to each day's program or event. ATA rules shall govern.
- All ties for trophies will be shot off the day the event is finished, time permitting. Failure to be present for a shoot-off will forfeit your right therein. Money will be divided in case of ties, except the Butte Medal.
- Singles and Doubles shoot-offs will be limited to 100 targets, and if still tied will be carried over.
- Ties will be shot off in the following manner: Singles 25, 16-yard targets; Handicap 25 targets; Doubles 10 pairs; All-Around 20 singles; 10 Handicap and 5 pair doubles.
- Please be ready when your squad is posted on the starting board.
- Hand loads permitted, subject to inspection for shot and powder specs.
- If you want your empty cases, please catch them before they hit the ground.
- Watch your scores. They cannot be changed after you leave the shooting post.
- Errors in scores must be corrected on the score sheets before you change stations. The management will refuse to enter into discusion on this point and will compile the scores as shown on the score sheets.
- Grievances will be handled by a committee of three on the grounds.
- This is an Invitational Tournament and the management reserves the right to reject, refund, or disqualify any contestant who interferes with the safety, conduct, accuracy, or sportsmanship of the Shoot. The management may exercise the right to change or modify this program in whole or in part.
- The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the classification of any shooter at any time during the tournament.
- On singles and handicap, only the "lost" targets will be called. In doubles, the results on both targets will be called.
- Practice traps are available each day. See each day's schedule for times.
- The Helena Trap Club will not be responsible for any accident or for loss of property.
- The Management will disqualify any shooter who has alcoholic beverages in his possession on the firing line. See ATA rule X11, B, 2.
- To win the ATA 100 straight pin, you must break 100 targets in one of the three championship events (Doubles, Singles, Handicap),no carry-overs. If you qualify, see Jim Jones. If you win the Helena Trap Club 100 straight pin for any event see the cashier. If you win the 100 straight pin in the championship events see Rick Dorr for the State Shoot firecracker pin or Helena's 100 straight pins.

Gunsmith




