Note: The Handicap Committee will assign a greater yardage than shown on their card for a shooter with less than 500 targets for the current and past two years: 300 of which must be handicap targets as of March 16, 2024. Such assignment will be at least Class B for Singles, 20 yard for Handicap, and Class D for Doubles.

Classifications

Class	Singles	Doubles
A	95% & Over	90% & Over
B	92% - under 95%	85% - under 90%
C	89% - under 92%	78% - under 85%
D	Under 89%	Under 78%

Jackpot & Special Purses

- ◆ All purses open to shooters from MT and all bordering States & Provinces.
- ◆ Perpetual purses are paid out at 50% of the current day's value.
- ◆ Ties divide.
- ◆ **6 Jackpot Purses:** Total starts @ \$8,590.
 - ◇ Must have 500 registered targets including 300 handicap.
 - ◇ \$2.00 entry fee for each purse = \$12.00
- ◆ **4 Corners Purse:** Total starts @ \$485.
 - ◇ Must shoot Event 1: Singles & Event 2: Handicap
 - ◇ First and last 25 of singles **AND** first and last 25 of handicap
 - ◇ Shooter must break all 100
 - ◇ \$5.00 entry fee
- ◆ **Gunner's 1st & 2nd Doubles Purse:**
 - ◇ 1st 50; purse starts @ \$385
 - ◇ 2nd 50; purse starts @ \$385
 - ◇ Shooter must break all 50
 - ◇ \$10.00 entry fee

Registration Certificate

- ◆ Classes: A, B, C, D
- ◆ Participate in all 3 Billings 2-day shoots:
 - ⇒ Memorial Shoot: Apr 20-21
 - ⇒ MT Singles Marathon/Grand Slam: Jun 8-9
 - ⇒ Don Rimmer Memorial Shoot: Sep 21-22
- ◆ Cumulative score of Singles, Handicap, & Doubles for all 3 shoots determines winner in each Class.
 - ⇒ The more events you shoot, the better your chances are to win your class!
- ◆ Winners determined by Singles Class ranking as of Don Rimmer Memorial Shoot.
 - ⇒ Class starts with Singles classification at Memorial Shoot.
 - ⇒ Advancements achieved during BTC ATA season determines final Class rank.
 - ⇒ No adjustments for lowering of Singles Class during BTC ATA season.
